Killings by bond bearing date the 13th day of February, 1825 in the sum
of one hundred dollars as also to the said John M. Surley by bond bearing
date the 18th day of February, 1825 for the sum of Forty dollars & seventy ac-
crued and the said John Booth being desirous to secure the payment of the several
debts to the said Patrick W. Killings & John M. Surley, there binds or assigns with all
charges attending the same or incurred by reason of the premises by conveyance, the
property herein after mentioned unto the said Saml Kille & Co. Trust, Now therefore
this Indenture witnesseth that the said John Booth in consideration of the sum of
one dollar to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is herby acknowledged hath
bargained and sold & assigned & made over & do by these presents bargain sell assign &
make over unto the said Saml Kille the following property to wit the interest in the
share of Martha Branches Mill which may be due to her in right of her wife Betty
also any interest in the share of Martha Branches which may be due her in right of
her wife aforesaid also 5 acres of land the said land was purchased at a public
sale from Lewis Branches Trustee indebted with the whole the said 5 acres was
redeemed after sale from the & Henry Branch & Co. Deesors & To Hold the said property
& interest above mentioned unto the said Saml Kille his heirs and assigns in trust upon
condition Nevertheless that, at any time hereafter whenever the said Patrick W. Killings
& John M. Surley desire to collect or either of them should desire to collect the debt
interest aforesaid it shall be lawful for the said Saml Kille or in case of his death
for his legal Representatives herby authorized to -- make sale of the property herein
before conveyed at public auction to the highest bidder for cash having first on
the day place of sale sent written shewing given reasonable public notice thereof and
only of the proceeds in the first place to discharge all legal & usual cost expenses
