This Indenture made the first day of October in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Richard Parker Merchant and his wife one right and John D Williams by writing in law one right of the first part and John Parker of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Parker (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by their presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Parker to all his right title and interest in &c certain tract or parcel of land of which the said John Parker the wife of the said John Parker had seized and possessed and which the said John Parker then held by writing containing an hundred acres more or less and bounded by the lands of the said John Parker together with all and singular the premises messuages and messuages remainder and appurtenances and also unto the said John Parker and of every part and parcel thereof To Have and to hold the said one hundred acres of land with the tenements buildings all and singular the premises heres and heres remainder or inheritance to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right Members and appurtenances to the said John Parker his heirs and assigns forever and the said Richard Parker Merchant Williams in her own right John D Williams by writing for themselves and their heirs the said one hundred acres of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Parker his heirs and assigns forever from the claims or claims of whom the said Richard Parker Merchant Williams and John D Williams they or either of their heirs and of all said of every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and so covenant and power defend by their presents in testimony whereof we the parties have hereunto set our hands and seals this day and date first above written equal words as followed in the premises of
