Williams by conveyance of rights of the said parts and also Parker & Co. of the other part, Whitefeild, that for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Sige Parker, (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Sige Parker to all her right title and interests in a certain tract of land of lands whereof the said Sige Parker wife of the said Sige Parker died seized and possessed and which tract the said Sige Parker now holds by conveyance containing one hundred acres more or less bounded by the lands of the said Sige Parker together with all and singular the former possession and succession remainder and remainder yearly and other rents issue and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said one hundred acres of land with the buildings thereon and all rights thereto the former having before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold in every part and parcel thereof with every of their right, masters and apprentices the said Sige Parker his heirs and assigns forever and the said Richard Parker Martha Williams his wife and eight children Williams by conveyance to them on their behalf the said one hundred acres of land with all and singular the former and appearance before mentioned with the said Sige Parker his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Richard Parker Martha Williams and S.
