Williams has by these presents relinquish all right interest &c which he or his heirs might have unto the said John Brule his heirs and assigns forever. Williams for and in consideration of the sum of Forty several dollars to him in hand paid by the said Elizabeth S. Williams formerly Williams & Virginia Bird the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Elizabeth S. Williams formerly Williams & Virginia Bird his interest in certain tract of land situate in the County of Southampton & more particular description will appear by reference to a deed from John R. Beale to the said James S. Williams bearing date the 30th of January 1865. Recalling the same day to have and to hold the above said interest in the land above described unto the said Elizabeth S. Williams formerly Williams & Virginia Bird & there and their heirs forever and the said James S. Williams will forever warrant and defend the title & interest to the above described land against himself and his heirs and all persons claiming by or under him.
