

This Indenture made this 11th day of March 1845 between Martha B. Rochelle of the one part and Harriett D. Moore of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, Witness that the said Martha B. Rochelle for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred dollars to her in hand paid by the said Harriett D. Moore at or before the making and delivery of these presents do hereby acknowledge have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Harriett D. Moore her heirs and assigns and legal or parcel of land lying near Germantown containing three hundred and thirty seven acres of land to the said Harriett D. Moore formerly belonging to the state of James R. Rochelle deceased and conveyed to the said James Rochelle by deed from Governor John B. K. Moore and to the said Harriett D. Moore together with the improvements thereon and appurtenances thereunto belonging to the said Harriett D. Moore her heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of her the said Harriett D. Moore her heirs and assigns forever and the said Martha B. Rochelle for herself and her heirs hereby covenants promises and agrees to and with the said Harriett D. Moore in manner and form following that is to wit that she the said Martha B. Rochelle and her heirs the said tract or parcel of land with the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Harriett D. Moore her heirs and assigns against the claims of her the said Martha B. Rochelle and her heirs and against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons by thought or under her but against the claims or claims of the other persons whomsoever. She witnesses whereby the said Martha B. Rochelle has executed at her hand and affixed her seal the day and date afore written.

This Indenture made this 2nd day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five between William L. Moore and John L. Moore of the one part and Harriett D. Moore of the other part, both of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia of the first part and Harriett D. Moore of the County and State aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty five dollars \$55.00 and lawful money of Virginia to her in hand paid by the said Harriett D. Moore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold at public auction agreeable to the last will and testament of the said late William L. Moore and certain tract or parcel of land situate and being in the County of Southampton and adjacent and by these presents of the said Harriett D. Moore administrator as appears do bargain sell these lands and confirm unto the said Harriett D. Moore her heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said late William L. Moore and lying in the County and State aforesaid of the South side of the three creeks and containing by late survey thirteen acres and bounded as follows by the land of said Harriett D. Moore of the one part and William L. Moore of the other and to the said Harriett D. Moore a parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
