 of seven hundred dollars to have and hold paid by the said Harrison D. Moore at or
 before the sealing and delivery of this present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have given grants bargained and sold and by these presents does give grant bargains
 sell and convey unto the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns and trust or
 parcel of land lying near Somerton containing three hundred and thirty seven acres of land
 to be the same more or less formerly belonging to the use of Sam'l Rochelle dead and
 conveyed to the said James Rochelle by deed from Edmund Bell To Harrison and to
 hold the said tract of land together with the improvements thereon and appurtenances
 thereto belonging to the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns to the
 sole proper use and benefit of him the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and
 assigns forever and the said Martha B. Rochelle for herself and her heirs hereby covenants
 promises and agrees to set with the said Harrison D. Moore on Marine and free following
 that is to say that she the said Martha B. Rochelle and her heirs the said tract or
 parcel of land with the improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto
 the said Harrison D. Moore his heirs and assigns against the claim of her the said
 Martha B. Rochelle and her heirs and against the claim or claims of all and every
 person or persons by, through or under her but against the claim or claims of the
 other persons whomsoever the witness whereof the said Martha B. Rochelle has hereunto set
 her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first above written

 Howell of the said Sol. M. Moore's dees & certain tract or parcel of land which runs
 Sol. M. Moore and myself and sufficient and by these presents the said Samuel D.
 Moore administrator as aforesaid doth bargained sell about eighty and eight acres the said
 Howell Harris his heirs and assigns forever of certain tract or parcel of land with all
 the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Sol. M. Moore his wife estate and myself in the
 County and state aforesaid on the south side of the three creeks and containing by
 like survey nineteen acres and bounded as follows by the tract of land of late Howell Harris
 wife B. Naylor and William A. Jones Esq. and to north the said surveyed about
 a parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any
