one tract containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less including the place
place and the interest of Lillian R. Edwards in the tract of land of which his brother
Richard Drake had bought & possessed which land is more particularly described in
said last which title has since been assigned to John A. Barley and whereas
since the execution of the said Indenture the said Drake has paid & satisfied
to the said Barley the debt aforesaid which the said Barley duly hereby acknowledges
Now therefore the said Lillian R. Edwards & John A. Barley for no consideration of the
premises as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the
said Barley by the said Drake the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by
