This Indenture Made and entered into this 17 day of March in the year 1843
 between William O. Swearingen trustee of the one part and Samuel Darrow of the other
 part sheweth that the above named William O. Swearingen trustee in &c. certain deed of trust
 executed by one George W. Williams for the benefit of certain creditors therein named bearing
 date the 1st day of 1844 Recorded in the Clerk's Office for the County
 of Southampton pursuant to the terms of said deed on the day of March 1844
 at the residence of said Williams till to the highest bidder among other things &c.
 certain parcel or lot of land conveyed by said deed containing twenty acres more or
 less lying on the north side of the road opposite the residence of the said
 Williams in the County of Southampton and adjoining the land on which said Williams
 resides known as the Farrell tract and also the lands of Robert Killy and
 Ed. Dickinson and whereas Robert Killy became the purchaser of said parcel or
 lot of land for the sum of one hundred dollars who afterwards purchased the above
 named Samuel Darrow to take the same in consideration of his paying the purchase
 money. Now Therefore this Certificate witnesseth that for and in consideration of the
 purchase and for the further consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars in hand
 paid by the said Saml. Darrow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said
 William O. Swearingen trustee as aforesaid has given granted and conveyed and did by these
 presents give grant convey and release unto the said Saml. Darrow all right title
 and interest which he has at any time had or possessed in or to the above
 above described lot or parcel of land do have and to hold the said lot or parcel
 of land to the said Saml. Darrow and his heirs forever and the said William
 O. Swearingen for having his heirs &c. see by these presents cannot & will void the
 said Saml. Darrow his heirs forever to warrant and defend the title to the premises
