Williams of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John B. Sherrill for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Nathl. C. Williams at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof the said John B. Sherrill hath herby acknowledged) he the said John B. Sherrill hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed unto by these presents unto the grant bargain sold alien released and confirmed unto the said N. C. Williams his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract of land with its appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing two hundred and thirty eight acres by the same more or less. The land is known as water back and is the dower of Mrs Sarah Turner left to her during her Natural life by her late husband Capt. Edmund Turner late and to the said John B. Sherrill only coming to the said Wm. Williams the dower right to the said land which he said Sherrill purchased of Mrs Sarah Turner he the said John B. Sherrill did hereby warrant and defend the right and title of the said dower land to the said N. C. Williams his heirs &c. In Testimony whereof the said John B.
