This Indenture made the 20th day of December in the year of our Lord 1744 between John B. Therrell of the County of Northampton & State of North Carolina of the one part and Nathaniel O. Williams of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John B. Therrell for and in consideration of the sum of thirty dollars of lawful money to him in hand paid by the said Nathaniel O. Williams at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof the said John B. Therrell doth hereby acknowledge) he the said John B. Therrell hath granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed unto by these presents unto the grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said N. O. Williams his heirs and assigns forever all that certain tract of land with its appurtenances situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia containing two hundred and thirty eight acres be the same more or less. The land is known as water back and is the dower of Mrs. Sarah Turner left to her during her Natural life by her late husband Capt. Edmund Turner doth and to the said John B. Therrell only coming to the said Williams the dower right to the said land which he said Therrell purchased of Mrs. Sarah Turner he the said John B. Therrell doth hereby warrant and defend the right and title of the said dower land to the said N. O. Williams his heirs & assigns whomsoever. The said John B. Therrell hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and year first above written.
