Bryant administrator of Daniel B. Wardlaw and by C. deane from the County Court
of Southampton for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars
and forty cents of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by
the said Nathaniel Francis at or before the making and delivering of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold unto by the
premises said bargain and sell unto the said Nathaniel Francis his heirs and
assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in
the County of Southampton and bounded as follows beginning at a Maple or
branch a corner for John Light in Nathaniel Francis line thence the various
courses of Branch to C. deane and out in the lower line of Henry Wardlaw
thence to a short gum a corner for Henry Moore a corner in Southampton
thence thence to C. deane and out a corner for the lower land in Henry Moore line
thence to C. deane a corner for John A. Noel in Henry Moore line thence
to C. deane in branch a spring and out to me to the beginning containing
by survey three hundred and twenty eight acres do have and to hold the
aforesaid tract of land together with all the appurtenances belonging to it in any
wise appertaining and all the privileges to and for the only proper use of
him the said Nathaniel Francis his heirs and assigns forever all the interest
