James Drury for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred dollars to
him in hand paid by the said Thomas B. McNamee at or before the sealing
of delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both grants
bargains and sells and by these presents doth grant bargains and sell unto him
the said Thomas B. McNamee his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land (hereinafter lying and being) in the aforesaid County of Southampton & parish of Saint
Johns containing by estimation two hundred and fifty acres to the same more or less
to hold the western part of the tract of land and Drury's purchase of Drury
5.5 acres and bounded by the limits of said Thomas B. McNamee & Bayard family and
by C. Lee Drury at 3 bushes standing on the road & tree corner for small
