This Indenture made the 24th day of April 1823 between William B. Griffin of
the first part William B. Shanks of the second part and Harrison D. Moore of the
third part witnesseth that whereas William B. Griffin is justly indebted to Harrison
D. Moore in the sum of thirty dollars due by bond payable the 25th of December
1823 which debt the said William B. Griffin is willing and desirous to secure

Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promise and also
for the further consideration of one dollar good money of Virginia in hand paid by
the said William B. Griffin to the said William B. Shanks under the receipt thereof is hereby
acknowledged at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents that the said
William B. Griffin hath given granted bargained and sold unto by these presents doth give
grant bargain and sell unto the said William B. Shanks his heirs and assigns forever
one parcel here one loggy one house do here and to hold the said personal
property unto the said William B. Shanks to have his heirs and assigns forever After
which hereafter that the said William B. Shanks shall permit the said personal
property to remain in the quiet and peaceable possession of the said William B. Griffin
until default shall be made in the payment of said debt of thirty dollars above
mentioned then the said William B. Shanks shall upon due request made by Harrison
D. Moore after having given two days notice thereof by advertisement at the Court house
do proceed to sell at public auction for Cash the said personal property now out
of the money arising from the sale thereof first pay all costs arising from the
execution of this deed then pay to the said Harrison D. Moore the said debt
of thirty dollars together with the legal interest thereof accruing and the balance of
any sum due to the said William B. Griffin his heirs and assigns but if the whole of
the said sum of thirty dollars shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said
Harrison D. Moore his heirs or assigns at or before the 25th of December 1823 when
the same is payable so that no default shall be made in the payment of the said
sum of thirty dollars then this Indenture to be void and remain in full force and
virtue that William B. Griffin doth give the said parties to these presents their heirs and assigns
hereby affixed their seals the day and year first above written
