This Indenture made & entered into this 1st day of May 1853 between
Rockville / William S. Roberts of the first part Edward Beale of the second part and
Henry Daniels / and N. J. Williams of the third part witnesseth that the
said Roberts & Williams doth make and enter into this indenture and wish to secure their agents any loss either
Williamson as principal or security "that is in consideration of the sum of one thousand
of one dollar in hand paid by the said Beale the principal whereof is
now acknowledged the said Roberts hath the day foregoing sold unto
Account of 2 delivered and due by the said persons foregoing bill for one dollar and one
tenth Recd unto the said Beale all his wear of every kind (not sacrifice except)
Pay 45% commissary of his interest in at least of land lying on Main street
in the Works aforesaid the house of Samuel Barham & containing about one hundred
feet by the same more or less also all his growing crop of every kind
whatever and all other description of property. Not having mentioned it long
the right of the said to convey unto the said Beale every thing
belonging in any way to the said Roberts. The said Beale to hold all the
said property with him the said Beale has had & always had
therefrom heretofore that the said Beale shall keep all the said
property together & make the growing crop a meadow when he shall
after giving reasonable time of the time and place of sale all the
said property at public auction for cash and out of the proceeds pay to
Henry Daniels & N. J. Williams as debt of one hundred & twenty dollars & 50 cents
that they paid off for said Roberts the 1st July 1853 also to sell
of about forty four dollars due Davis Smith for loss of wages with
N. J. Williams as security for about 20th Decr 1853 also the cost
of removing the execution of the trust. On the second floor \$ 200.00 being
fifteen & twenty of two hundred and thirty one dollars 00/00 being
date 21st June 1853 One do. third floor \$ 200.00 due N. J. Williams
of one hundred and fifty dollars & Henry Daniels \$ 200.00 due
one hundred and eighty dollars & seven & eight cents bearing date the 21st of
June 1853 One & twenty of two hundred and thirty one dollars
