This Plaintiff made the 1st day of May in the year of 1845
between Edward Beaton of the first part William L. Rechelle of the second part
to Nat J Williams and Henry Hunter of the third part all of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said Edward Beaton stands
fully indebted to Henry Hunter in one hand of one hundred and twenty
five dollars bearing even date with these indentures and other hand of one
hundred and twenty four dollars dated 5th day of May 1845 with N. J.
Williams security and the said Edward Beaton, do willing and desirous to
secure the sum of one hundred and Nat J. Williams as security. Now the
Plaintiff wherefore that for and in consideration of one dollar to him
in hand paid by the said William L. Rechelle to the said Edward
Beaton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged with grateful language and
sent to the said William L. Rechelle, and tract it or part of land
lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded by the road
from and down creek containing by estimation twenty acres more or
less three bushels of Guinea and there increase crop of corn, fodder grains
and potatoes and the said Edward Beaton for himself his heirs & deli-
vering agrees to and with the said William L. Rechelle that is to
say the said Edward Beaton shall hereby convey unto the said
William L. Rechelle and do warrant and defend by these presents
upon Trustee Notwithstanding whenever the said Nat J. Williams or Henry
Hunter or their assigns do thinks proper to order the said William
L. Rechelle to sell the above named property to satisfy the aforesaid
debt interest and cost to the highest bidder for ready money at
public auction by giving at least ten days notice at such places
as the said William L. Rechelle may think proper and shall tell by
request of either of the parties and not of the forecited from all
cost and then pay unto the said Henry Hunter the amount of the
sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars with interest, however
also his other hand of one hundred and twenty four dollars with
Nat J. Williams security with interest thereon and the conjecture if any
pay to the said Edward Beaton for which whereof we have herunto
set our hands and affix our seals the day and year first written
