use of his person and belief forever and the said Chamberlain and Spomer for
themselves their heirs & assigns remain and agree it and with the said
Turner his heirs and assigns that the will forever remain and defend the
said tract of land hereby conveyed to the said Turner his heirs and assigns
against the claim of themselves and of all persons claiming the same by or
through them or either of them but against the claims of no other person
