said Governor Ogden at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
do bargain and sell unto the said Governor Ogden his heirs executors admors
& assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate and lying in the
County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by and well being having received
for good and lawful containing two hundred and sixteen acres more or less and
bounded as follows vizt North by the land formerly owned by Eliza Crocker
late by the land of Mrs. Devere and the land belonging to the estate of
Eliza Vick late South and west by the lands of Robert S. Griffin from
which it is separated by a clear creek running together with all appurtenances
thereto belonging the aforesaid and recessions growing and due rents issues and
profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to the said Ogden and
heirs of him the said Governor Ogden his heirs and assigns forever and
the said Arrington Vick for having his heirs and assigns so received
and gave against the title to the said land and premises against all
