and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred & four dollars to them in hand
paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Francis O. Jones & Unten
his wife have granted conveyed & sell and by these presents do grant convey & sell
unto the said Matthew Jones to his heirs and assigns a certain tract parcel
of land containing three hundred sixty seven three fourths acres by late survey lying and
being in the County of Southampton State of Va bounded as follows to wit beginning
at some Maple or hick bottom Above some Church along said line to east end of
the Road thence to corner pine in said swamp thence along said swamp to corner maple
at large Camp line thence along said swamp to its boundary to state swamp thence along
said swamp to its boundary to White Road at A B thence line thence along said line
to Road thence along said Road to corner Rock oak by reference to the plat to wit
said the boundary will more fully than do hereby and to hold all and singular
the above premises unto the heirs and assigns of the said Matthew Jones his heirs and
assigns forever and we the said Francis O. Jones & Unten his wife the aforesaid land premises
unto him the said Matthew Jones to his heirs and assigns with covenant as do the said
Francis O. Jones & Unten his wife & all and every person or persons whatsoever shall & well
lawfully and forever defend by their persons and writings whosoever as do the said Francis
