 trustee to a debt of Bond executed by John Beale to bond as trustee to
 second James of Williams security for the said John Beale in a note due to
 Andrew M. Howell in the sum of thirty three dollars, whereas the said
 John Beale was anxious to indemnify the said James S. Williams against any
 loss or account of the said securityship "Windsor" that the said John R. Beale
 trustee as aforesaid having advanced the lands conveyed by the said James
 agreeable to the terms of said debt and exposed the said at public sale to the
 highest bidder, where James S. Williams bought the premises at the sum of eight
 dollars and twenty cents there forewards Therefore Windsor that for and in
 consideration of the premises the said John R. Beale has granted bargained and sold
 and conveyed unto the said James S. Williams and to his heirs forever the said
 John Beale's undivided interest in a certain tract or parcel of land lying and
