Edwards the hereunto the following property to wit: Tracts of all lands here growing unto him to him the said T. R. Edwards his heirs & assigns forever. Upon Trust. Nevertheless that as any time hereafter about the said Grants & Manry shall suffer by the several severalships it shall be the duty of the said T. R. Edwards upon being thereto requested by either of the several parties in the hereunto of either party sell the property above named after giving legal notice of the true value of said land and one of the parties arising from said land pay all expenses attending the land then pay the debt for which the said Grants and Manry stands bound as security and the balance of any sum to the said T. R. Edwards his heirs & assigns and the said T. R. Edwards covenants with the said Edwards that he is possessor of a few simple tracts in the property above conveyed and promising during the parties have become by their lands and debts the day and year first before written.
