This Indenture Made the 24th day of December in the year four Lord
1844 between said Barnes of the first party Richard B. Dargum of the second
part and William C. Myrick of the third party Whereas the said Richard B.
Dargum on the 19th day of March year four Lord 1844 in order to secure
the payment of the sum of two hundred and twenty five dollars to the said
William C. Myrick did by indenture of Deeds of that date convey to the said
said Barnes his heirs executors &c the following property to wit a certain tract
or parcel of land containing one hundred and twenty one acres more or less as to
boundary the said deed of land for the use and purpose in the said Indenture
hereunto and whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of land
the said Richard B. Dargum hath fully satisfied and paid to the said William
C. Myrick the sum of twenty thirty dollars which the said William C. Myrick
doth hereby acknowledge And this Indenture witnesseth that for and in considera-
tion of the sum of one dollar as well as for the further consideration of one dollar no bond paid by
the said Richard B. Dargum to the said said Barnes at and before the executing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the
said said Barnes with the assent and approbation of the said William C. Myrick
signified by his hand joining to these presents and the said W. C. Myrick hath
conveyed and sold removed released and confirmed and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said Richard B. Dargum all the
wholly sole interest claim and demand both at law and in equity which the
said said Barnes now or shall in the lands so as above named do have and
to hold the said both or parcel of land &c as aforesaid to the said Richard
B. Dargum his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever to his only proper use
and behoof of him the said Richard B. Dargum his heirs executors or administrators and
assigns forever and the said said Barnes & W. C. Myrick for themselves their heirs
executors and administrators the above mentioned Deeds &c as aforesaid unto the said
Richard B. Dargum his heirs executors administrators and assigns in as full and ample
manner as the same was warranted by the said Richard B. Dargum by the deed
of date above recited do warrant the same to the said Richard B. Dargum against
the claims or claims of them the said said Barnes and William C. Myrick and all persons
claiming by or under them or either of them And with the above the parties to these
