Third Indenture made and entered into the twentieth day of March one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Benjamin Weeks, husband, Troy Weeks his wife of the first part and of the County of North Carolina and State of North Carolina and William Neal of the County of Guilford in the State aforesaid witnesseth that the said Benjamin Weeks and his wife Troy for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Neal before the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge their bargained and made unto the said William Neal his heirs and assigns forever their interest in all certain tract pieces or parcels of land situated lying and being in the County of Guilford in the state of Virginia lying on the east side of the road leading from Somersel in said County to the Town of Piedmont and bounded by the lands Charles B. Vaughan, wife Sally and William of Leake being one hundred and twenty four acres thereof so having and to have the said lands premises and all the rights and privileges to have the said William Neal his heirs and assigns forever to him and their only proper use benefit and behoof and the said Benjamin Weeks and Troy his wife will jointly answer and defend the title to the above mentioned premises to the said William Neal his heirs and assigns free from the lawful bills and demands of all and every person whatsoever. Attest witnesseth the said Benjamin and the said Troy their hands set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year above written
