 appurtenances thereto belonging. His Ma^{ty} shall be hold the said tract or parcel
 of land & the said undivided interests with their appurtenances to him the said
 Robert Ridley his heirs and assigns to the said party of the first part & the said
 Robert Ridley his heirs & assigns forever and the said George Nicholas by
 Argueval G. Davis his attorney for himself his heirs executors and administrators
 doth hereby ^{convey} grant and agree to and with the said Ridley his heirs & assigns
