This Indenture made this 25 day of August 1845 between James Drake of the  
first party Augustus H. Williams of the second party and specially L. Williams of the  
third party whereas the said James Drake is indebted to the said Operatory L. Williams  
to me at least for two hundred dollars & 75 cents Oct. Demand the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August  
1845 and the said James Drake is desirous to secure the said L. Williams against  
any loss which he might sustain in account of the aforesaid debt Now therefore  
I James Drake willing that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him  
in hand paid by the said Augustus H. Williams the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged by the said James Drake do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said  
L. Williams A. H. Williams his heirs or the following property to wit and by these  
my last and final wills and testaments I further give him my  
chairs one table short and long set and office crockery ware of all kinds knives  
forks and set of cutlery late together with all other household kitchen furniture forming  
a house to wch has belonged this writing has also my goat and pair of geese which  
and lot of timber, and third of the crop of coal fodder peats and feathers and growing  
at certain pieces of land in estimation by the said Drake two sheaves one great three  
two half bushel bushel and one & a half together with all other property of every description  
which the said Drake owns and possesses the same and to hold the property above  
named unto him the said A. H. Williams his heirs or legal Executrix Notwithstanding  
that the said A. H. Williams shall at any time hereafter again being required by  
either of the aforesaid parties after giving legal notice of the time and place of sale
