 thousand eight hundred and forty three between Thomas Vaughan and Maria
 his wife of the first part and William Vaughan of the second part all
 of the County of Southampton and State of the Kingdom of Great Britain that the said
 Vaughan and Maria his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of Three
 dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Vaughan the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and
 sell alienate release and convey unto the said William Vaughan his heirs and
 assigns forever all their right title and interest in the dower of Mrs
 Temperance Harwood who was the widow of Henry Vaughan dead at the dower
 the dower from her former husband's estate and Wm. the said James Harwood and
 Temperance Harwood his wife conveyed to the said Wm. Vaughan which will fully
 appear by reference to the Records in the Clerk's Office of the County to have
 and to hold the aforesaid dower together with all the right title and interest
 thereto belonging unto the said Wm. Vaughan and Maria his wife to have
 and to hold unto them and their heirs forever the same free from all the claims or claims
