thousand eight hundred and fifty three between Thomas Vaughan and Maria  
his wife of the first part and Willing Vaughan of the second part, all  
of the County of Southampton and State of N.Y. Whereas the said Sir  
Vaughan and Maria his wife have for and in Consideration of the sum of Thirty  
dollars to them in hand paid by the said Willing Vaughan the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged herewith and sold and do by these presents bargained and  
sold above to witness and confirm unto the said Willing Vaughan his heirs executors  
and assigns forever all their right title and interest in the sum of One  
Thousand Dollars who was the widow of Henry Vaughan late aforesaid deceased  
the several sum of her former husband estate and left the said James Vaughan and  
Thomas Vaughan his wife engaged to the said Willing Vaughan which will fully  
appear by reference to the Records in the Clerks Office of the County of Suffolk  
and to hold the aforesaid sum together with all the right title and interest  
thereunto belonging unto the said Sir Vaughan and Maria his wife to hereby  
convey and will forever defend the same free from all the claims or claims  
demands or demands of all and every person whatsoever until the death of the  
said Sir Vaughan his wife and his executors whereupon as the parties have  
hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year as is before  
mentioned.
