This Indenture made and the 13th day of January year 1845 between Charles Peper
lives in a certain tract situated by Thomas Barnes bearing date day of December
year 1840 in and by which tract stands his certain lands or parcels of land
lying in the County of Litchfield the boundaries of which will appear by referring
to said tract which were measured for purposes herein named which tract stands in
the name of Barnes in the County aforesaid in possession of said Barnes
by said date to the said Charles Peper date the 13th day of December year
1845 still at and in the above named lands and James Barnes through
Alexander Megrath his agent became the purchaser thereof for the sum of one thousand
and fifty dollars Now the Testifiers witnesseth that the said Charles Peper tenanted
as aforesaid in consideration of the sum aforesaid as aforesaid unto the said date and time
expressed as aforesaid by said tract have and do hereby grant bargain sell as by said
deed described the lands named in said deed and to the said James Barnes bearing
purchaser thereof as aforesaid and fully completed with the terms of sale in
said deed he said Charles Peper having so hereby granted bargain and sell to
him the said James Barnes his heirs and assigns forever the above described
lands the contents of which will appear by reference to the said deed of said
James Barnes again to hold the before described his lands or parcels of land and
with all appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said James Barnes his heirs and assigns
forever and the said Charles Peper tenanted as aforesaid for himself his heirs
successors and assigns the said lands or parcels of lands and premises with
all their appurtenances to him the said James Barnes his heirs and assigns
shall and will by these presents forever and forever defend defend the rights
and title unto the said lands or parcels of lands the said Charles Peper and also agrees
all and every person or persons whatsoever Ist witness whereof the said Charles
Peper tenanted as aforesaid has hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal
