thousand eight hundred and forty five between Spentley School of the County of
Southampton and State Virginia of the first part George Moore of the said County and
State of the second part and Thomas A. Story of the aforesaid County and State of the
third part Whereas said Geo M. Taylor School for and in consideration of
the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said George Moore at or before
the making and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
as well for the further sum in consideration of the said Spentley School being
indebted to the aforesaid Thomas A. Story in the sum and full sum of forty dollars
(lawful money) of Virginia due by note bearing date January 1st 1845 amount
and forty five cents for the said Spentley School as more effectually to secure
to the said Thomas A. Story and in fact the full debt of these presents each granted
bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents each grant bargain sell convey
and confirm unto the said George Moore and his heirs heirs and assigns forever
granting on the land and also the sum that may be gathered and have the said
George Moore his heirs Executors and administrators But upon this Special Trust
and condition that the said George Moore his heirs Executors or administrators upon
demand being required by the said Thomas A. Story his heirs Executors administrators
or assigns to make date of the foregoing expenses at public auction for the best price
that can be obtained for the same after advertising the same five days at least at
some convenient place in the neighborhood or at the Court-house of said County and
with the money arising from the said that first pay to the said Thomas A. Story
the aforesaid sum of forty dollars with lawful interest from the date of the note aforesaid
