Midland Ward Model's contract int' this 1st day of August 1845 between Richard R.
Edwards of the one part and Mills & Lawrence of the other part to witness that the said
Edwards in consideration of the two debts of sume executed to him as detailed out by Samuel
D. Jones and the other by Samuel D. Jones & Sarah C. his wife and both admitted
to Record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County the first on the 1st day of
January 1842 and the other on the 26th day of February 1842 date on the 1st
day of August 1845 having given due notice of the time places & terms of sale sell
at public auction for cash on the 2nd day of September at certain tract of land lying
at Newbury over containing three hundred & five acres more or less also all the said
lands interest in the above tract & land of Nancy Jones by the state of her deceased
husband Samuel Jones making the intent which the said Samuel D. Jones purchased
of Miles Cooper & Sally Cooper his wife and at the said 26th day of February 1842 Mills & Lawrence
received the purchase of the tract of land aforesaid by the said Samuel D. Jones
the highest bidder saying that it to pay for the tract of land at the price of eight
hundred dollars and of the interest aforesaid at the price of six hundred dollars
making in the aggregate the sum of fourteen hundred dollars. Now therefore the said
Richard R. Edwards for & in consideration of the said sum of fourteen hundred dollars
to him in hand paid by the said Mills & Lawrence the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargained
& sold unto the said Mills & Lawrence his heirs or the heirs of said lands interest hereinabove
mention'd and doth declare to have and to hold the said tract of land & interest unto
him the said Samuel Jones his heirs & executors and the said Edwards warrants & defends the
title to the aforesaid lands & interest against himself only & all others alring of the said
Edwards both hiswreint set his hand and affixes his seal this day & year first aforesaid
