That Plaintiff made and entered into the 19 day of November last thousand eight  
hundred and forty four Deed of I. D. Mafersberg acting as lessees under a decree of  
the Circuit Court of Law and Chancery for the County of Southampton bearing date on the  
1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1804 and securing the title of a tract of Land in the parish of  
Woolwich on the first part and John Wardell of the second part Woolwich that  
whereas Iacob Ulrich and Augustus H. Ulrich in the forewriten Deed bearing date  
to comply with the conditions set forth in said Deed by the payment of the sum thereon  
mention'd the said tract of land has been sold at public auction by the said I. D.

Mafersberg and was purchased by John Wardell Now for want or consideration of the  
sum and the further consideration of three hundred and thirty four dollars paid and  
to be paid in manner following that is to say forty dollars yearly in cash and  
one hundred and twenty three & four pence nine farthings per month from time to come for which  
the said John Wardell has executed his bond or Note Stipulating the said James I.  
Mafersberg has bargained and sold unto these present sole bargains and sell unto  
the said John Wardell the tract of land in the said above mentioned containing two  
hundred and sixty acres the particular whereof will more fully appear by reference to a  
deed bearing date the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March eighteen hundred and forty three Executed by  
Iacob Ulrich and Loty his wife to Augustus H. Ulrich to have and to hold the  
said tract of land unto him the aforesaid I. D. Mafersberg and all and every person claiming  
by or under him as aforesaid the said tract of land the said I. D. Mafersberg this day and  
date above written

That Plaintiff made and entered into the 30 day of August eighteen hundred  
and forty four between Robert A. Gobell and Elizabeth his wife partie of the first part  
and Mr. Martin Marcell partie of the second part Woolwich that for and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty six dollars and eighty seven and twenty  
cents in hand paid by the said partie of the second part to the said partie of the  
first part the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said partie of the first  
part have bargained sold leased and conveyed and by these presents do lease and  
deliver and convey unto the said partie of the second part his heirs and assigns forever  
a certain tract of land being and lying in the County of Southampton state  
of Virginia and known as the Vaughan tract, contained by curved line hundred and  
five and thirty acres bounded on the North by the lands of Henry Marcell and  
John H. Neale on the East by the tract of John H. Neale on the South by the  
lands of Mr. Marcell and on the West by the estate swamp and the lands  
of Henry Marcell his heirs and to hold unto himself his heirs and assigns forever  
with all the rights title interest and appurtenances therunto belonging in and over  
affixing And the said partie of the first part for themselves their heirs  
and executors to keep execute and agree with the said partie of the  
second part his heirs and assigns forever to warrant and defend the right and title of
