William D. Blaw of the first party, Anne K. Stephenson of the second party, and Davis
Barrell of the third party, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas
the said William D. Blaw is partly indebted to the said Davis Barrell in the sum of
one hundred and twenty two dollars and 50 cts. due by bond and having said debt
on this indenture and the said William D. Blaw being willing and desirous to borrow
the aforesaid debt and interest, Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar to him the said William D.
Blaw in hand paid by the said Anne K. Stephenson at and before the reading and
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said
William D. Blaw such good and lawful bargain and sale made by these presents doth
give grant bargain and sell to the said Anne K. Stephenson her heirs and assigns
forever her the said William D. Blaw those crops of every golden wheat corn and
potatoes he have and to hold to her the said Anne K. Stephenson only proper
use and behoof forever Upon these acknowledgments that the said Anne K. Stephenson
shall at the request of either one of the aforesaid parties after giving at least
fifteen days notice of the time and place of sale sell at public auction all the
property aforesaid or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to satisfy the aforesaid
debt and that out of the proceeds first pay the expenses thereof then pay the
debt aforesaid of one hundred and twenty two dollars and 50 cts. with the debt and
the balance of any pay now to the said William D. Blaw or his legal representatives and
the said William D. Blaw covenant with the said Anne K. Stephenson that he is
possessed of an absolute fee simple right in all the property hereby conveyed and
that he will forever warrant and defend the same against himself and all
