

John Collins voluntarily that the said Mary's Vicks for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred & two dollars to her in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged but bargained granted & sold and by these presents do fully and absolutely grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Madrell his heirs executors administrators & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying in being in the County of Southampton State of Virginia containing by estimation three hundred fifty acres by the same more or less the same being the back of land devised to the said Mary's Vicks by her father Joseph Vicks dec'd in virtue as follows by the lands of David Griffin the plantation on which Joseph Vicks dec'd lived and also the property of James Vicks & the lands of Peter Pinckney & others To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land together with all and singular the premises and improvements thereto belonging or in any way appertaining thereto to the said John Madrell his heirs executors administrators & assigns forever and the said tract is free and clear of all manner of incumbrances whatsoever and the said Mary's Vicks do for herself by her executors administrators & assigns do promise and agree to warrant and save defend the lawful right against the lawful claims or claims of any person or persons whatsoever or claiming the same or any part thereof that whosoever shall hereunto set any hand and offend say and this day well wote about witness

This indenture made the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1723 between Edward Slaughter of the first part James Vicks trustee of the second part and Springin Slaughter executor of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witness that the said Edward Slaughter for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said James Vicks at & before the executing & receiving of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as the further consideration of these presents that the said Edward Slaughter being partly indebted unto Springin Slaughter in the sum and full sum of fifty five dollars did by hand at this time which is the last effects of these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto James Vicks to have and his heirs forever the following stocks to wit three hundred of cattle with their increase and the hogs and their increase but upon this special trust and condition that the said Slaughter shall pay unto the said Slaughter his bond and interest therein and all cost in making sale of the above mentioned stocks of cattle and hogs & convey unto the said James Vicks all right title to the above mentioned stocks & that upon this special trust and condition that the said James Vicks his heirs & assigns upon being required by the said Springin Slaughter his heirs or assigns shall make sale of the above mentioned stocks at public sale any time after the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1723 after advertising 10 days before the day of sale at least twice over and as many other places as the said James Vicks may see fit and the money arising from the sale shall first pay to
