This indenture made the sixth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and forty five between Nelson B Barker of the County of Kingspoint
 in the State of Virginia of the one part and John M Perkins of the County of
 Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part; whereas Samuel Robertson in
 being the payment of a certain debt due John M Williams and by indenture of
 bond to the said Nelson B Barker all his interest in life estate in and to a certain
 piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton
 adjoining the lands of John B Perkins Jordan Edwards; Whereas B Barker contains
 English and was a life for the use and purpose in said indenture contained to be sold
 at or after a specified time first advertising the time and place of sale a return
 thereon for the specifications therein expressed and the said land having been duly
 advertised as aforesaid by said indenture of bond the said Samuel Robertson voluntarily
 in the same was exposed to public sale to the highest bidder on the first day of
 October 1798 about John M Perkins became the purchaser of the same for the sum
 of one hundred twenty five dollars and fifty six cents Now This Indenture witness
 that the said Nelson B Barker for and in consideration of circumstances aforesaid
 and for the further consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five dollars
 and fifty six cents to him in hand paid by the said John M Perkins at and
 before the making and delivery of this present the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Nelson B Barker hath granted bargain sold and
 by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John M Perkins his heirs
 and assigns the interest or life estate of the said Samuel Robertson in and to the
 said piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of
 Southampton and containing eighty acres more or less as aforesaid which is the same
 piece or parcel of land conveyed by the said Samuel Robertson to Nelson B Barker
 in bond the 20th day of February 1794 for the purpose therein expressed and
 contained in therein described and herein recited together with all such appurtenances
 premises and appurtenances thereto in any way appertaining and
 every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of
