Myrick of the same County and State of the other party witnesseth that the said Alexander Myrick and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars Current Money of Virginia to have in hand paid by the said William S. Myrick at or before the date and delivery of these presents doth receipt and have received of the said William S. Myrick his heirs and assigns forever and certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and part of Great Tidewater containing twenty five rods to the southward (or less) of being the land late Alexander Myrick purchased of William S. Phillips (as per the boundaries of which will appear by reference to the said first and Phillips' map to said Myrick) 30 acres and to hold the said tract or parcel of land will promises each all and singular its appurtenances lands belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said William S. Myrick his heirs and assigns forever to and for the sole proper use and behoof of him the said William S. Myrick his heirs and assigns forever and the said Alexander Myrick and Sally his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators and assigns make and agree to and with the said William S. Myrick his heirs executors administrators and assigns that they will by their present warrant and power defend all the right title interest claim demand of and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever for nothing aboveof the said Alexander Myrick and Sally his wife have herunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year first above written
