That Indenture made the 17th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred forty five between C. B. Whithead of the one part of the County of Suffolk, knight and Esq. of Virginia and William Dargatz of the County of Southampton and John Dargatz of the other part, Witnesseth that the said C. B. Whithead for and in consideration of the sum of thirty eight dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Dargatz the receipt whereof the said C. B. Whithead hath hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold by these presents to grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William Dargatz his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation thirty four acres be the said tract a little more and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows on the east by William Dargatz's tract bounded on the south by the lands of Catherine Dargatz on the south-west by James Hill's swamp on the west the said tract of land with all the tenements and appurtenances unto the said tract belonging in any way appertaining to the said William Dargatz his heirs and assigns forever and the said C. B. Whithead the said land with all the tenements and appurtenances referred and the said W. Dargatz his heirs and assigns so free from all claims or demands of all and every person whatsoever shall will and lawfully demand save Testimony whereof he has hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written.

Whereas a deed was returned at August Court for a sale of the land of which Daniel Vick dec. deced. and Joseph and Robert Dargatz was appointed Special Commissioners to make sale of said land which he did after advertising the land on the 15th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five and John Davis dec. Because the purchase for the land of two hundred and fifty dollars and twenty five cents in which deed the Commissioners are directed to make a deed of Special commission to Messrs. C. B. Whithead and Edward D. Edwards as Commissioners appointed in the year of our Lord Christ 1853 between C. B. Whithead as Commissioner of the one part and John Davis of the other part, Witnesseth that the said C. B. Whithead as Commissioners referred in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars and twenty five cents of lawful money of the Commonwealth to him in hand paid a deed to be paid by him at a before the meeting and selling of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold by these presents to grant bargain sell and convey unto the said John Davis his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land as above described containing one hundred and thirty acres be the said tract a little more and being by the lands of Samuel Hill's and James Hill's and then together with all and singular the houses and houses appurtenances granted granted afterwards unto every person and every person's heirs and assigns
