Bray at a before the executing and delivery of these presents have bargained and sold and by these presents do give each of them unto the said Matt J. Bray a tract or parcel of land bounded as follows beginning at a black oak standing on the north side of Brown's road at the foot of Cedar's path about sixty feet further a north west corner a line of two-hundred feet to a straight standing the north side of the double prong of the Northbrook Swamp thence down the north side of said Swamp to a white oak a corner thence north the said Swamp a line of hundred feet to the south of the ridge branch of the main run of said branch a double oak to a leaning oak a corner line standing at Brown's road at the North side thence up the said road to the first turned corner in the beginning four hundred and one to the same line or left to here and to thence the said tract is parcel of land with the tenements heretofore and at singular that the premises herein before mentioned or referred to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights Members and appurtenances unto the said Matt J.
