This INDENTURE made and entered into this first day of December one thousand
eight hundred and forty five between Nathaniel J Williams and Mary A his wife to
the one part and John M. Burley of the other part witnesseth that the said Nathaniel J.
Williams and wife for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to him or
land found by the said School - H. Burley the scrivener, whereof he hereby acknowledges
have granted to himself \$1,000 and by these presents do grant, bargains and sell unto the
said John M. Burley his heirs and assigns an interest in a parcel of land lying partly
in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia and partly in the County of Northampton & State
of North Carolina containing by recent survey twelve hundred and thirty two acres more or
less situated immediately on the Nankin river and bound by the lands of George W. Gray
Henry Hunter Sarah J. Burley alias the late residence of the said Nathaniel J. Williams
together with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in any
wise appertaining. It is agreed and stipulated between the said Nathaniel J. Williams
and John M. Burley his heirs and assigns forever unto the said Nathaniel J. Williams retaining
to his wife to hereby agree to covenant and forever discharge the right and title to the above
described tract of land against the said John M. Burley his heirs and assigns forever
and also for the further consideration of the sum of thirteen hundred and fifty five dollars
to them in land found by the said School - H. Burley the scrivener, whereof he hereby acknowledges
unto the said Nathaniel J. Williams & Mary A his wife have granted, bargained and sold
unto these presents to grantee and his heirs unto the said School - H. Burley his heirs and
assigns one full and equal moiety (in value) of a certain tract of land lying partly in
the Counties of Southampton and design described to certain fifteen hundred rods to the said
Nankin river being the said tract a parcel of land owned by Sarah J. Williams which the said
Williams purchased at the date made by Nathaniel J. Williams and Testator P. Edwards witness
to a deed of Deed executed by the said Sarah J. Williams for the length of two cables
together with all the appurtenances to the said tract a parcel of land belonging or in anywise
appertaining. To have and to hold the property aforesaid unto the said John M. Burley
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Nathaniel J. Williams & Mary A his wife do
hereby agree to covenant the said John M. Burley above named unto the said parcel of land his heirs
