and before the writing hereof of those pounds the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
yet have bargained and sold unto by these presents unto grant bargain and sell to the
said Josiah Worrell & Charles S Knight a certain lot or parcel of land lying in the said
County of Southampton is being identically the same land which was assigned over
to the said Martha Whitfield as her distributionable share of the land of which George
Whitfield died seised and possessed the land was through as well as transfer of record
therein will be by referring to said Commissioners Report which is of Record in the Clerk
Office of said County To have and to hold the said lot or parcel of land with all the
