

This Sixty-fifth Month and entered into the 15 day of December 1848 between
 Edwards Butts ^{Complainant} of the one part, and John J. Powell of the other party, defendant
 Commissary by a decree of the County Court of Southampton made at the October Term 1848 in a
 suit thereon pending between James Barnes & others plaintiffs against Peter Edwards when
 Plaintiff it was agreed between said Edwards Butts who is appointed a Commissioner
 for that purpose after advertising the time place of sale for one month by advertisement in
 the Courtland Star or some Court day and at least three places in the neighbourhood of
 the land sold to the highest bidder at Courtland and some Court day on a credit of twelve
 months except, make sufficiently to defray the expense of the sale and of the sale, the
 land of which Carroll Barnes then subject lying in the County of Southampton well
 containing two acres more or less. And whereas the said Edwards Butts Commissioner
 agreed after having given the notice the above aforesaid required date on the 15th day of
 December 1848 being Southampton Court day sold to the highest bidder in Courtland the
 tract of land of which Carroll Barnes then subject lying in the County of Southampton
 containing four hundred acres more or less and at the sale to said the said John Powell
 became the purchaser of the said tract of land by bidding therefor the sum of four
 hundred dollars and 50 cents which was the highest bid made for the same. And therefore
 the Plaintiff Edwards Butts ^{Complainant} as aforesaid after having given the notice
 in consideration of the sum paid of the said sum of four hundred dollars and 50 cents
 a part of which sufficiently to defray the expense of the sale and of the sale being paid in
 cash and the balance secured by bond with good security, said Plaintiff Edwards Butts
 and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said John J. Powell his heirs and
 assigns the land of which Carroll Barnes then subject lying in the County of Southampton
 well containing four hundred acres more or less bounded (as believed) as follows on the
 west by the lands of Mrs. Neale and on the north by the land & by the lands of Barnes
 & by the lands of Peter Edwards (there is a small portion detached from the Barnes
 land to Powell and to Neale the premises above comprised unto have the said John J.
 Powell his heirs & assigns forever and the said Butts hereby conveys to said John J.
 Powell that he will warrant and bear about the tract of land hours before conveyed unto
 him the said John J. Powell his heirs and assigns against the claim title or amount of sum
 the said Edwards Butts and those claiming by descent or otherwise but against Barnes
 title or amount of the other person or persons holding still retaining during the said
 Butts his heirs & his assigns his tract of land the day & year first aforesaid
 signed sealed & delivered.
