

by said Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 5th day of December 1725 to take effect from the expiration of the Term of the present Sheriff and to continue in office until the first quarterly Court to be holden for the said County in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty one. And there for the said Jacob Barnes shall take and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues paid into his hands for collection and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees are due respectively at such times as are presented and limited by Law and shall well and truly execute and discharge the whole of all process payable to him therefor and pay and satisfy all sums of money and charges by him received by virtue of any such writ process to the persons to whom the same are due and his own clerks administrators or assigns and in all things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform the said office of Sheriff during the Term of his continuance therein due the above obligation to be well observed to remain in full force and virtue signed sealed and acknowledged at
