above named Commissaries for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and
fifty dollars and 25 cts the receipt whereof the said above named Commissaries doth
acknowledgeth heretofore bargained and sold unto the said Willard Stephenon a sum and
his heirs forever in certain tract of land situate in the parish of Southampton
A. C. containing by estimation one hundred acres for the sum of one hundred and
fifty dollars of James Clayton Alfred Stephenon and son doth remit together
with all building so appertaining thereto to have and to hold the same unto
the said Willard Stephenon to him and his heirs forever and the said Commissaries
John Edwards, William J. Stephenon, Alfred Stephenon and son doth by
these presents convey all right and title to the said tract of land above named to
them to in trust as the Commissaries appointed by the said County Court to settle thereon
