leave presents unto Eliza Bryant and tell to the 2 Eliza Bryant a certain tract
or parcel of land situated the 2 Champlin and wife now lies containing only acres
more or less the same being the land that Martha Champlin widow to her late
husband Elbert Champlin and lying near the town has bounded as follows viz of
Tompson & Raw lands on the North side of the road on the east Dennis Bryant
on the South Joseph Gray and Elvert Bryant on the west and the 2 Elbert
Champlin and wife Marinda Champlin their heirs executors administrators or
successors and assigns the good will and trade from all present and hereafter unto the
2 Eliza Bryant her heirs executors administrators or assigns the aforesaid tract or
parcel of land with all its tenements and improvements thereon to the my proper
use and behoof of her the 2 Eliza Bryant her heirs to forever to release and discharge the
parties herein set their hands and affix their seals this day and year above written
