This Indenture made and entered into this 33 day of December in the year of our lord christ our thousand eight hundred and sixty five between Winchey McHenry and Alley his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Walsingham of the one part and Benjamin Worrell of the same County and parish of the other part Witnesses that the said Winchey McHenry and Alley his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars Current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Worrell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Worrell to him and his heirs forever a certain lot or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred acres to the same Ben Worrell and his heirs forever to have and to hold unto the said Ben Worrell and his heirs forever together with all houses and edifices buildings yards gardens orchards ways water and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any way appertaining to the said lot or part of land and premises to have and to hold the same unto the said Benjamin Worrell to him and his heirs forever and the said Winchey McHenry and Alley his wife doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Benjamin Worrell his heirs and assigns that they will warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof Whosoever the said Winchey McHenry and Alley his wife both jointly and severally doth their lands and affords this date the day and date first above written
