Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty four Edward Edwards Wife of the County  
of Edge of weight of the one part, and John Kitchin of the County of St. James of the  
other part, do hereby certify that the said Edward Edwards and Archibald Adamson and  
Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred Dollars  
lawful Money to them by the said John Kitchin in hand paid the receipt whereof  
the said Edward Edwards and Archibald Adamson and Elizabeth his wife do hereby  
acknowledge have granted bargained and sold out by their private de quod bargain  
and sell and convey unto the said John Kitchin his heirs and assigns a certain tract  
or parcel of land containing twenty seven and 1/2 acres be the same more or less lying  
and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit on the north  
by the land of William D. Morris on the north by the land John Kitchin's wife  
and by Betty Kitchin and on the south by the Spring Branch To have and to  
hold the said tract or parcel of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging to  
him the said John Kitchin his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof  
of the said John Kitchin his heirs and assigns forever and the said Edward Edwards  
Archibald Adamson and wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators do  
hereby covenant and agree to and with the said John Kitchin his heirs and assigns  
that they the said Edward Edwards and Archibald Adamson and wife and their heirs  
the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said  
John Kitchin his heirs and assigns against them the said Edward Edwards Archibald Adam  
son and Elizabeth his wife their heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall and  
may so covenant and forever defend On Witness whereof the said Edward Edwards  
and Archibald Adamson and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their hands and  
affixed their seals this day and year before written

the said deed being signed sealed & delivered the same & without let or hindrance
