This Indenture Made this 20th day of October 1745 between Sarah Sawyer
of the first part Thos Gorden of second part and Isaac Thomas & Edm^o
Adams of the first part of Thomas & Adams of third & last part all of the County
of Isle of Wight and state of Virginia whereas the said Sawyer is partly indebted
to said Adams the last Thos Gorden & Adams one thousand pounds and for one hundred and only four
dollars four cents payable 31st June 1745 signed by Droror Sawyer who have been
holding under the name Sarah Sawyer & A. J. Droror the due for one hundred and
seven dollars & twenty cents due by Sarah Sawyer undividedly and unpaid by her
payable to said Thomas & Adams October 17 1745 which debt with the legal interest
thereon the said Sawyer is willing and desirous to leave Wilkesboro that for unto an
consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Sarah Sawyer on hand paid by the
said Thos Gorden at and before the last sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof a hunc verbae acknowledge by the said Sawyer and granted hereupon
and debt unto the said party of the first part to confirm to the said
Thos Gorden his heirs and assigns forever a Regn Soc^t Estuaria one Bay board
one single Tug & hounds one bridle & saddle two Peals staves and formards & mending
sixty 18 barrels of best 500 pounds barrel one due & due horse one fine old stall
in safe condition together with all the property & appurtenances to the said Tug
Cot Seamus and other personal property about hundred in my own appertaining
belonging the horse and to hold to him the said Gorden his heirs & assigns forever
and to the said Sawyer for himself his heirs executors & administrators his
Gorden his heirs & assigns be the said Sawyer well and his heirs executors & administrators shall
covert & defend the same to the said Gorden his heirs & assigns from against the legal
claims and demands of all persons whatsoever upon or trust notwithstanding the said
Gorden his heirs & assigns shall permit the said Sawyer to remain in quiet & peaceable
possession of the said Tug Cot Seamus and other personal property and to take the
goods although in his own use until defunct to him in the payment of said sum
herefore described in whole or in part and then upon the further death that the
said Gorden shall and will to bear after the happening of such defunct of payment
as he shall be entitled by the said Thomas & Adams the executors & administrators
or assigns to do to the said Tug Cot and other personal property and it appears
unjust or such just thereof as shall be sufficient for the payment of all debts
to the largest bidder for ready money after having fixed the time and place of sale
at his own discretion and given ten days notice thereof by announcement at the court
house door and in the town of Wilkesboro and elsewhere in the County of Isle of Wight
