of One thousand dollars to be paid by George Booth to the said Clark Williams for the benefit of his  
Wife and Children of the County of Southampton, of the one and Clark Williams  
of the same County and State of the other party witnesseth that the said Clark  
Williams as trustee for and in Consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars and  
fifty cents to him in hand paid by the said Clark Williams it is before the  
witnesses subduly of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
that he did receive and pay over and delivered unto the said Clark Williams  
therein set and caption unto him the said Clark Williams his heirs and assigns  
from me certain tract a part of land lying and lying in the County of  
Southampton and known as the tract of land on which the said George Booth  
did erect and possess containing four hundred and fifty acres to the same  
tract also adjoining the lands of Elmer Cochran Henry Ward Belton Harris  
and others together with all the right title entered claim a demand of no more  
to the above described tract except of land and premises with its appurtenances  
thereby belonging or in any way appertaining to have and to hold the aforesaid  
tract a part of land and premises with all and singular its appurtenances  
thereby belonging unto him the said Clark Williams his heirs and assigns forever  
to be for the sole profit use and benefit of him the said Clark Williams his  
heirs and assigns forever and the said Bond & Pipe for themselves his heirs and  
assigns at his sole and entire command and agree to and with the said

and every part thereof stand against the claims a demands of himself only
