This Indenture made the fourteenth day of November the year eighteen hundred and forty five between Samuel Branch of Lenoxfield & son of the one party and Abram Branch of P. 6th and state of the other party Whipperfield being the said Abram Branch in order to secure the payment of certain debt due from him the said Abram Branch to Samuel Branch as aforesaid bearing date on the day of November 1845 eighteen hundred and forty five well spent fully agrees and makes acknowledgment of the sum of one dollar a week in blank space by the hand of Abram Branch at or before the recording and delivery of this present indenture whereby he hereby acknowledges to the said Abram Branch hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents with yearly garners and set unto the said Abram Branch the following property to wit and to have and to hold the said Abram Branch the following property to wit and to have one acre one rood and one half and the future income of the said property eight shillings and the future income of the female slaves from time now and shall future commence till freed and to hold the said property above named forever before witness. Neverthelss that the said Abram Branch shall at no time as referred by the said Samuel Branch as the said Abram Branch may think fit give notice of same publick three hours thereof the existence of the said Abram Branch and after having given two days notice set to the highest bidder for sale current money of Virginia and out of the money arising from the sale in the first place pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending such sale and then the debt above named and the interest thereon and the residue of the

money arising from such sales or aforesaid debt first or bonds and aforesaid
