This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of February 1786 between
John R. Chambliss one of the first part and David Turner of the second part,
Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Superior Court of law and chancery for South-
west Virginia in the said County of Boone pronounced on 3rd day of May
1785 John R. Chambliss was appointed a Commissioner to sell the land of which Thomas
Turner's late legal and lawful interest at the sale of the said lands made according to
the terms of the said decree the said David Turner became the purchaser of that part
of the land lying on the west of the main road leading through a long narrow
land to Harpers bridge containing 387 acres for the sum of four hundred and sixty
dollars then in consideration of the premises and for the consideration of the said
sum of \$460 to the said Chambliss in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said Chambliss his granted and conveyed unto by these
present words and covenants, all and every unto the said David Turner his heirs and
assigns all that part of the land of long narrow land above described containing
387 acres more or less To have and to hold the said land together with all its
appurtenances to have the said David Turner his heirs and assigns forever with
the said Chambliss heirs, as aforesaid covenants to defend the title to the said land
against the claims of himself his heirs and all persons claiming through him his
heirs and assigns against the claim of no other person And Testimony whereof the said Chambliss
