This Indenture made and entered into this 15th day of February 1748 between
John R. Chambliss one of the first part and David Turner of the second part
Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Supreme Court of law and chancery for Southamp-
ton County in the last Term of the said Court pronounced on 3rd day of May
1745 John R. Chambliss was appointed a Commissioner to sell the land of which Benjamin
Turner's debt is due and whereas at the sale of the said lands made according to
the terms of the said decree the said David Turner became the purchaser of that part
of the land lying in the west of the main road leading through a Bay's Turner
Land to Raleigh's bridge containing 387 acres for the sum of four hundred and sixty
dollars then in consideration of the premises and for the consideration of the said
sum of \$460 to the said Chambliss in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged by the said Chambliss has granted sold and conveyed with by these
persons with grant, sell and convey unto the said David Turner his heirs and
assigns all that part of the land of Bay's Turner's debt above described containing
387 acres more or less To have and to hold the said land together with all its
appurtenances to have the said David Turner his heirs and assigns forever And
the said Chambliss leaves as aforesaid covenants to defend the title to the said land
against the claim of himself his heirs and all persons claiming through him his
against the claim of no other person And Testimony whereof the said Chambliss
