THIS INDENTURE made and entered into me that 15th day of October 1845 by and between Elbert, Shannell and Maranda Bennett his wife and Derry Bryant, his first son, and John Vick of the second parish all of whom reside in the County of Bathampton this Ordinance established they the said Elbert, Shannell, Maranda his wife and Derry Bryant have for and in consideration of the sum of fifty eight dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Vick the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged though the said Elbert, Shannell, Maranda his wife and Derry Bryant have engaged and still are by these presents to and each of them shall jointly and severally have the said John Vick his heirs and assigns their and each of their interests in and to a certain lot or part of land lying in the County of Bathampton and bounded by the lands of the said James Vick Sandford, Daniel's Marshall Blanton which lot is supposed to contain forty four acres of land to the same more or less at the right side of the river and within which lies the said Elbert, Shannell and Maranda his wife and Derry Bryant, his wife and the said land for him the said James Vick and his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said Lot of Land and every part and parcel thereof free from the claim of them the said Elbert, Shannell, Maranda his wife and Derry Bryant, or either of them heirs and also free from the claims of all persons
